## INFORMATION SHEET

This school operates all year round with a special six-week Summer Program

### Hours of Operation & Tuition Costs

Monday – Friday

**Preschool: 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM – Regular Day: \$550 per month**

**Preschool: 7:30 AM – 5:00 PM – Extended Day: \$595 per month**

**Elementary School (1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup> grade) – Regular Day: \$495 per month**

**Elementary School (1<sup>ST</sup> – 5<sup>TH</sup> grade) – Extended Day: \$550 per month**

**Summer: Session: 800 AM – 5:00 PM – \$165.00 per week**

**Office hours: 7:45 AM – 4:45 PM Monday - Friday**

### Who Should Apply?

Parents of children that are toilet trained, ages 2.5 – 5<sup>th</sup> grade.

### How to Apply

Applying to our school is easy. First, submit a completed application form with the **non-refundable application fee of \$150.00**. Once these have been received, an interview with our Director will be scheduled for the parent(s) and child/children. **Once accepted, you will need to submit a completed Medical Form before the child is admitted to the classroom.** Our school participates in the CACFP Program which provides three healthy meals to our students in the Preschool Division each day – breakfast, lunch and an afternoon snack. Students in the Elementary Division pays \$3.00 per day – breakfast, lunch & afternoon snack or the option of providing lunch. Once enrolled, the child is expected to be in school for all sessions. All absences must be accounted for.

### Uniform

**Boys:** Sky-blue shirt; navy blue tie, navy blue pants, black shoes and navy socks.

**Girls:** Sky-blue blouse, navy blue tie, knee length navy blue dress or skirt (no pants), black shoes and navy-blue stockings/socks.

Uniform **MUST** be worn every day EXCEPT on Dress-Down Days, during the Summer Session or when the child is having a birthday. On these occasions, **girls are allowed to wear modest casual dresses or skirts with tights/shorts under (no pants), no exception.** Children who are not in uniform will be given a mark of demerit.

**Boys must have their hair cut short. braids, designs, mohawks, and ponytails are not allowed. The wearing of jewelry is NOT permitted** since they can present a danger for the child during playtime and naptime.
